- ★ General: Two historical "boreholes" noted in the northern area. Borehole 1 is 91cm deep and borehole 2 is 88cm deep. Currently investigating

- \* It must be noted that in December monthly monitoring of the wetlands and dam was undertaken on the 12<sup>th</sup> Dec and therefore water levels might be higher than that would have been expected at the end of the month when data collection is normally undertaken.
- Rain gauge data supplied by Niel van Wyk records 3mm for Dec indicating the lowest rainfall since monitoring started in 2007. Jan rainfall totalled 7.5mm.
